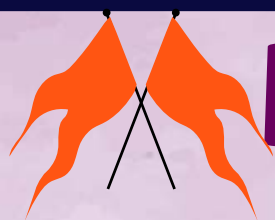




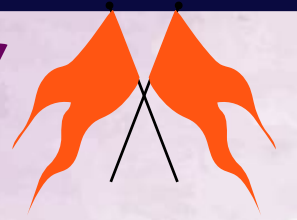
STUDENT COUNCIL ELECTIONS

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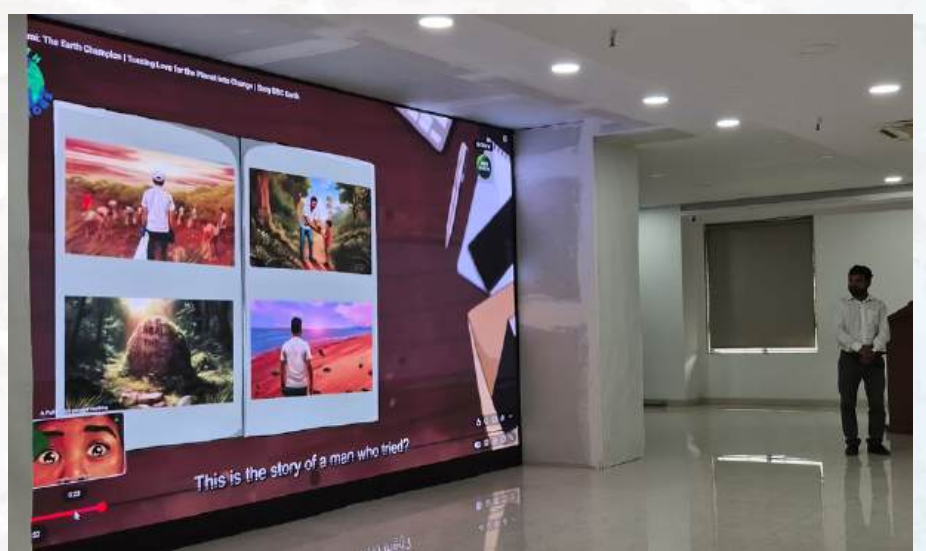

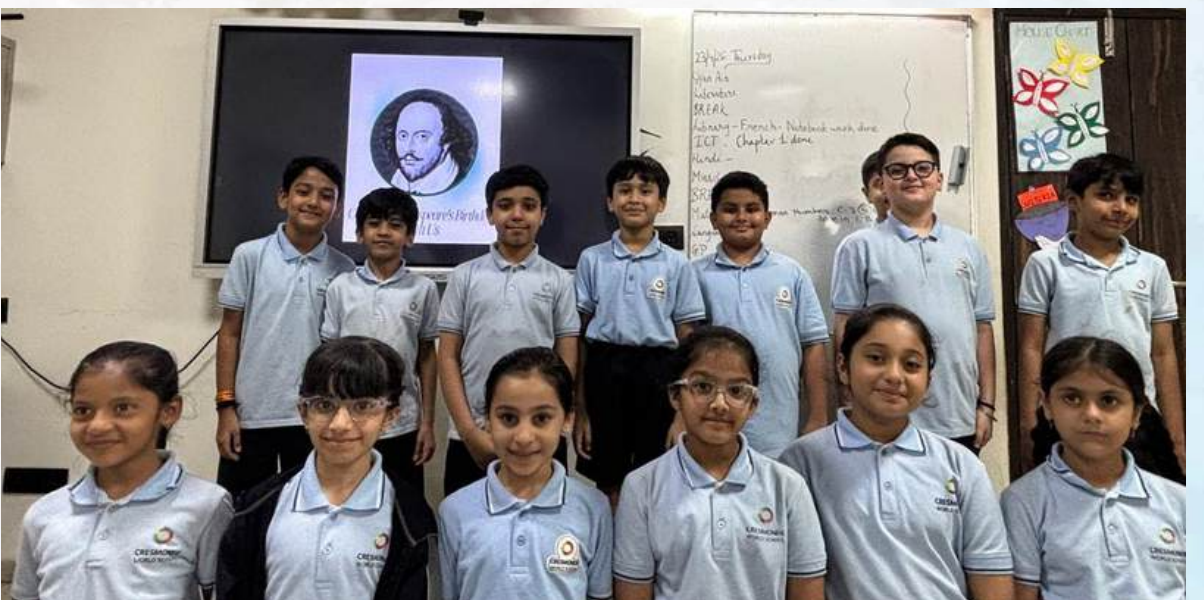
FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

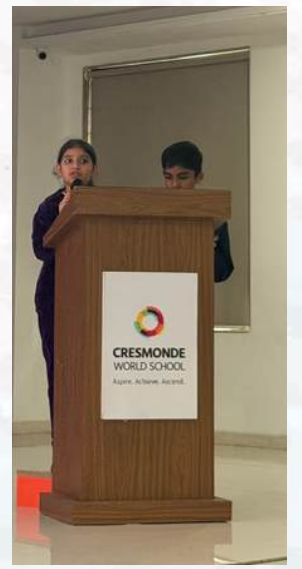
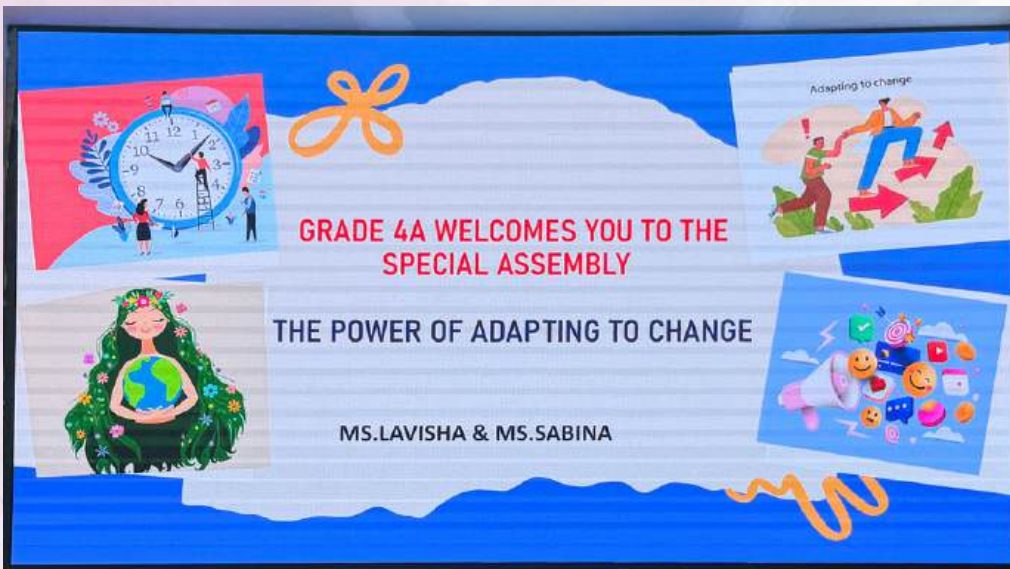
SESSION ON GOOD TOUCH AND BAD TOUCH

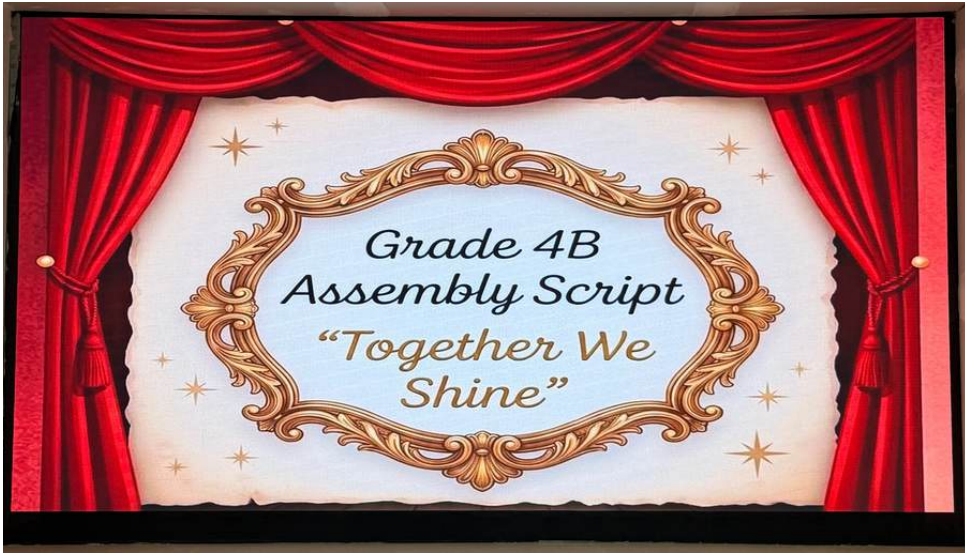
4A CLASS ASSEMBLY

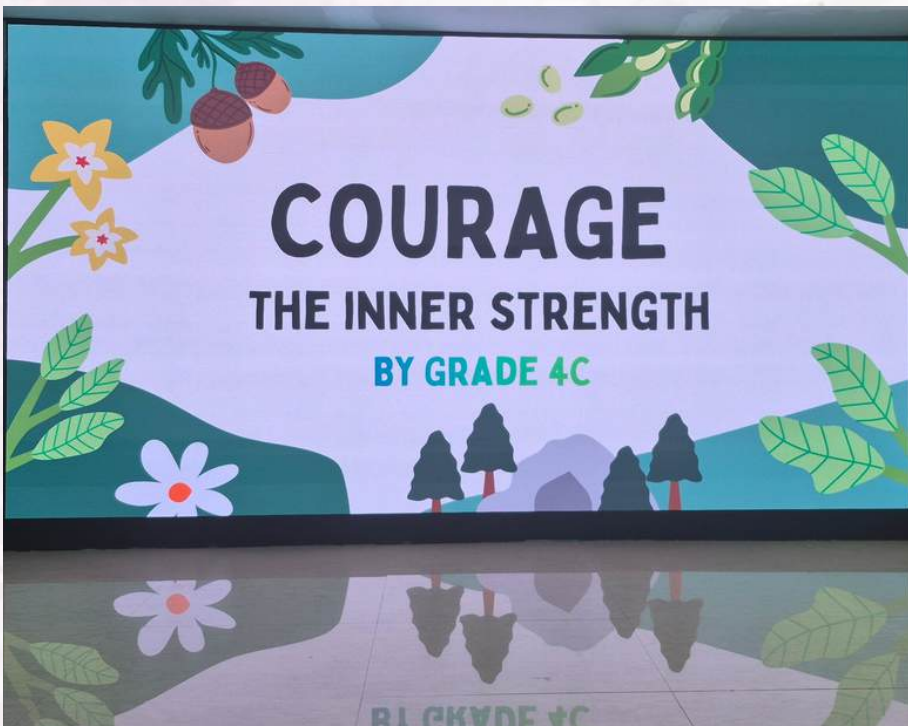
4B CLASS ASSEMBLY

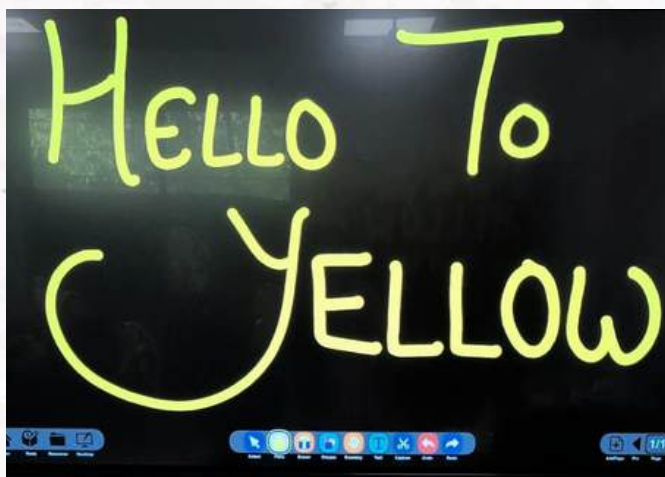
SENSE BOOTH
