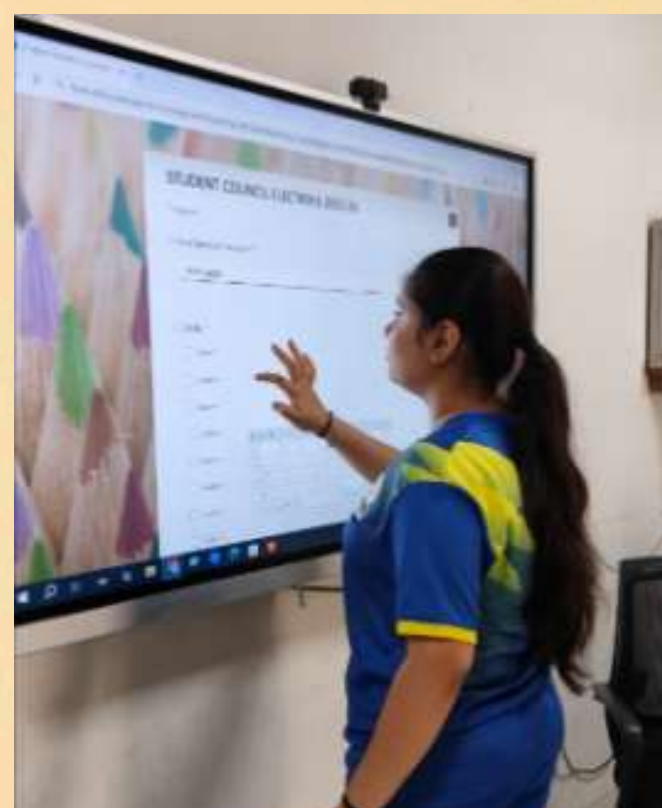
This initiative aligns with our school's commitment to give business exposure to budding entrepreneurs, who face the daunting challenge of convincing seasoned investors to believe their vision.

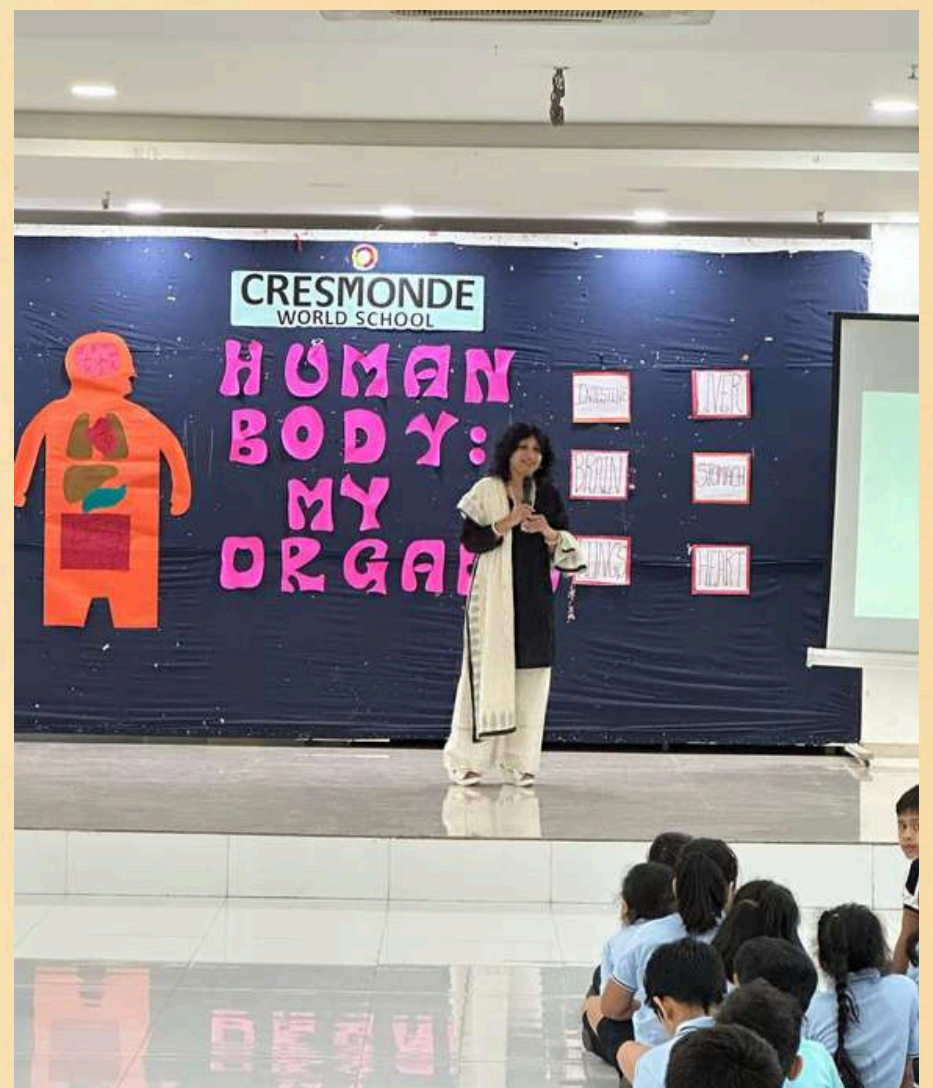

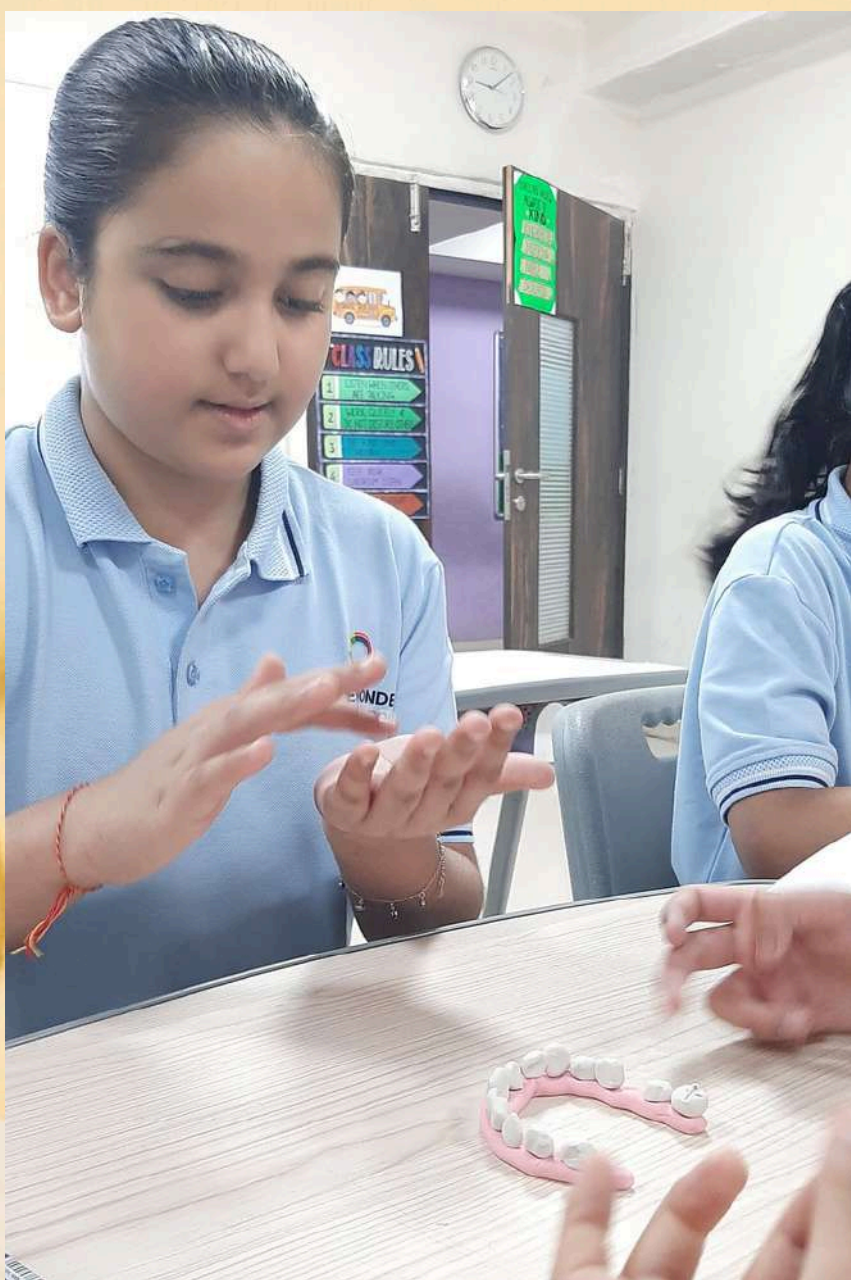


TOOTH TALLY

EARTH DAY – SMALL ACTS, BIG IMPACT!



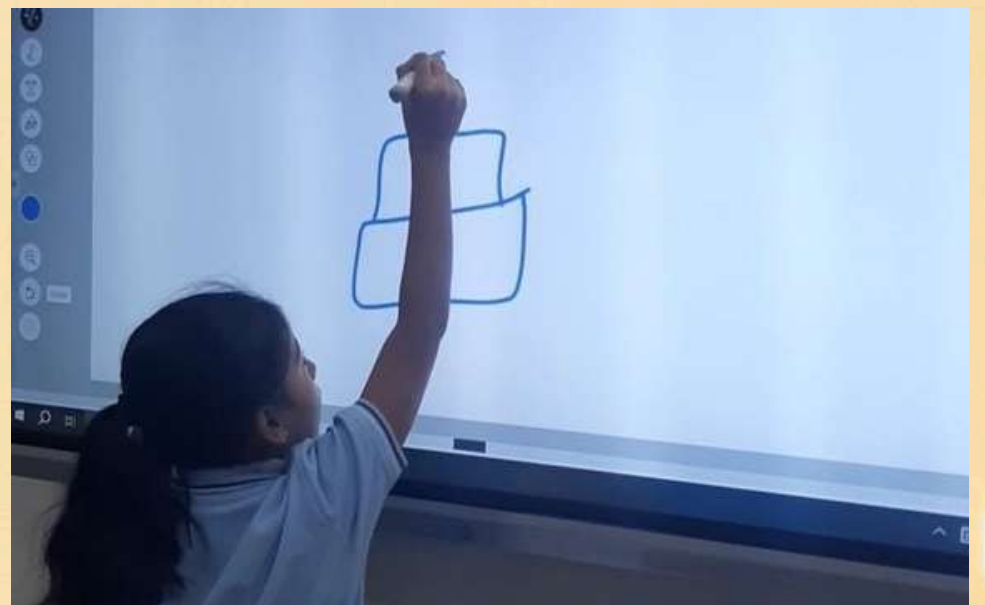
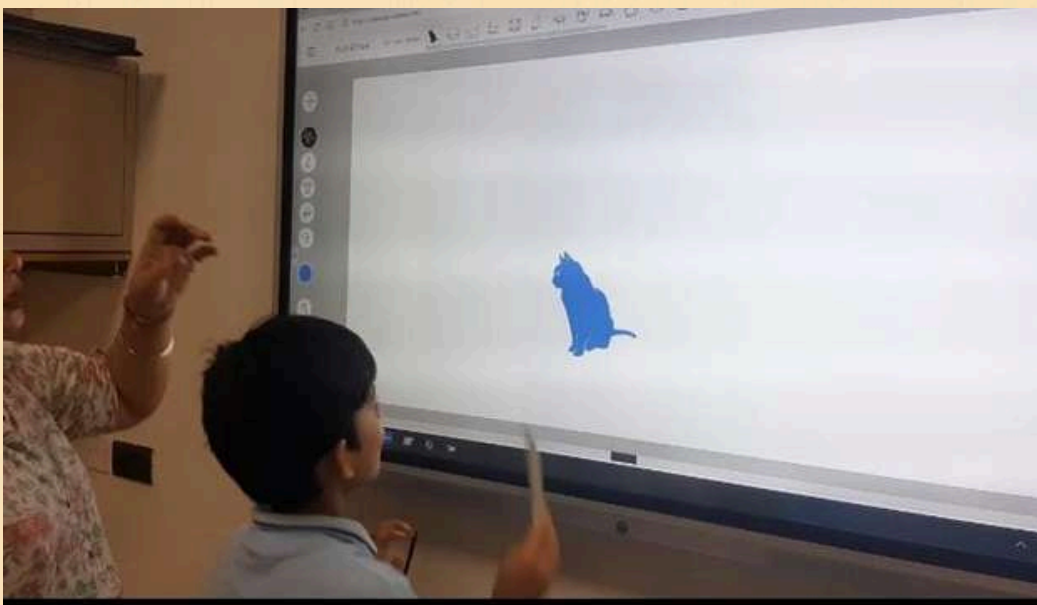
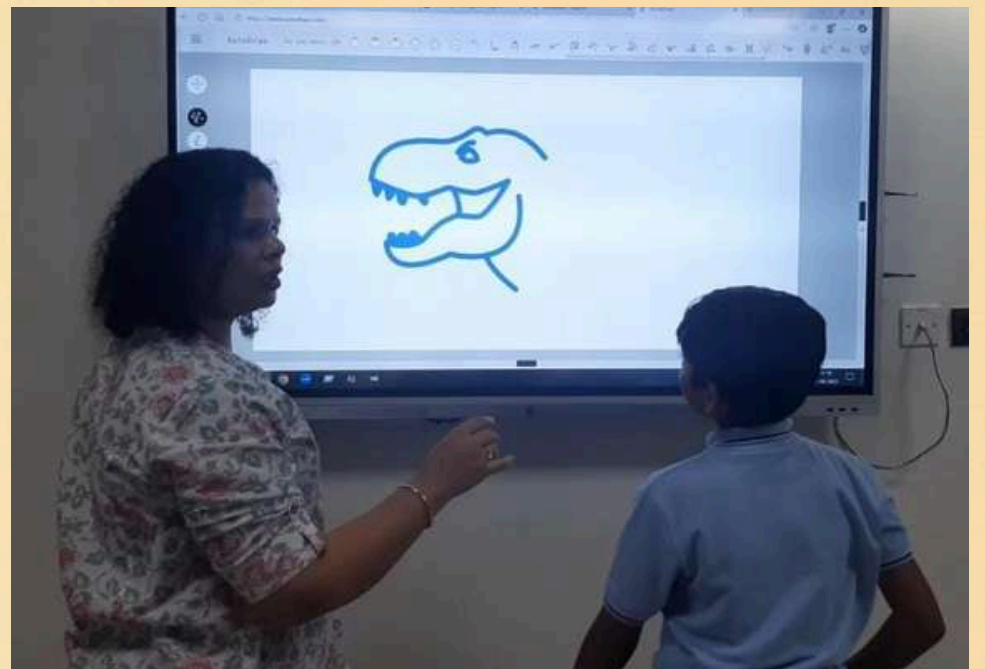

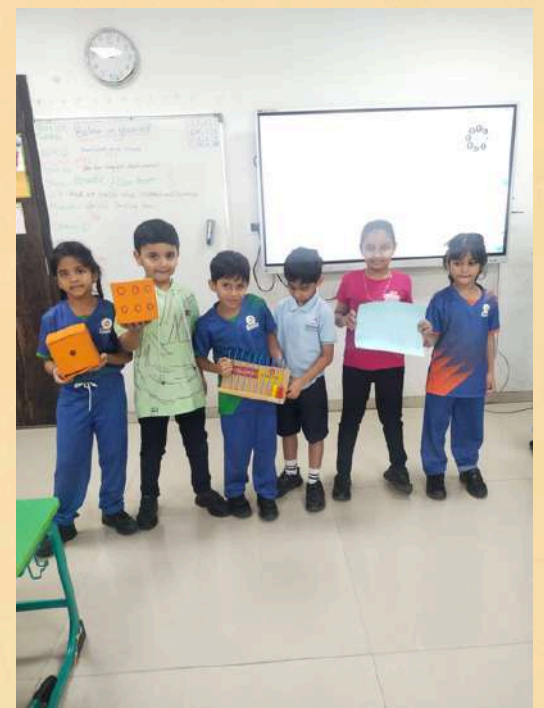
A SPLASH OF CREATIVITY – PRIMARY SECTION EXPLORES THE NEW ART ROOM

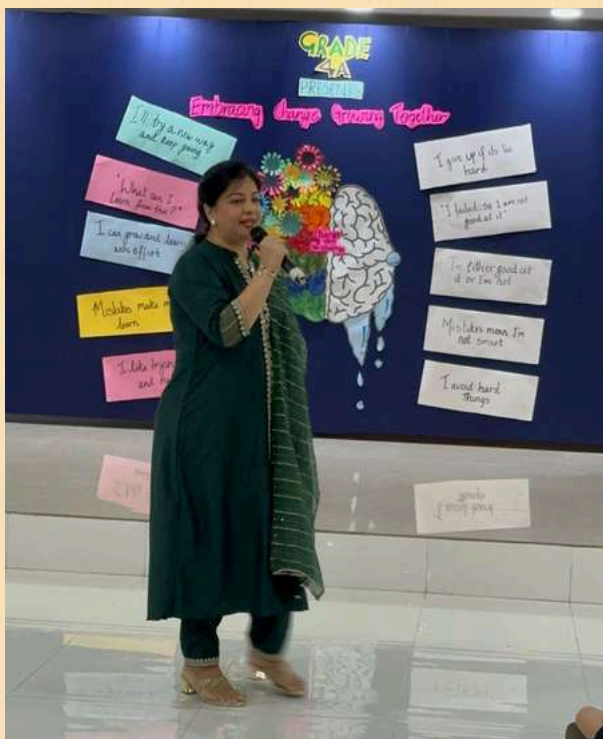
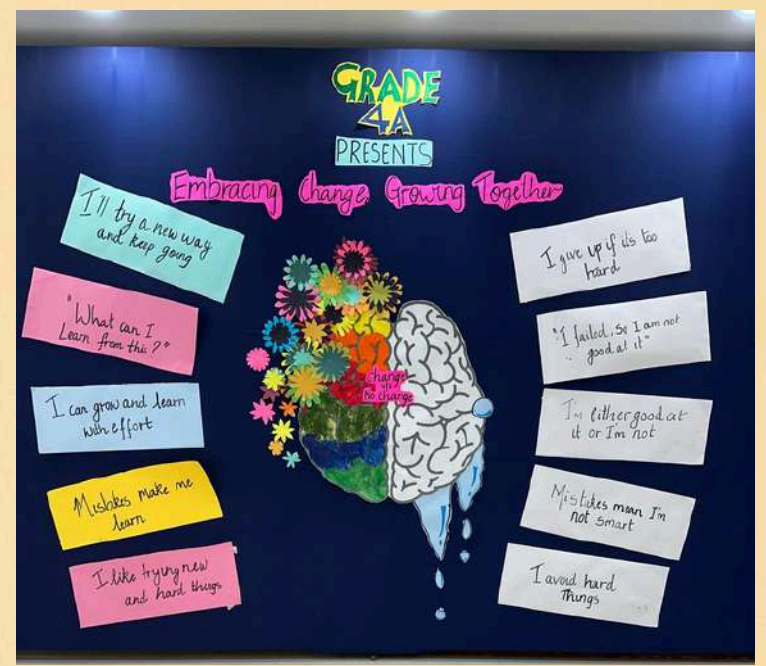
EVS ACTIVITIES– BODY SYSTEMS

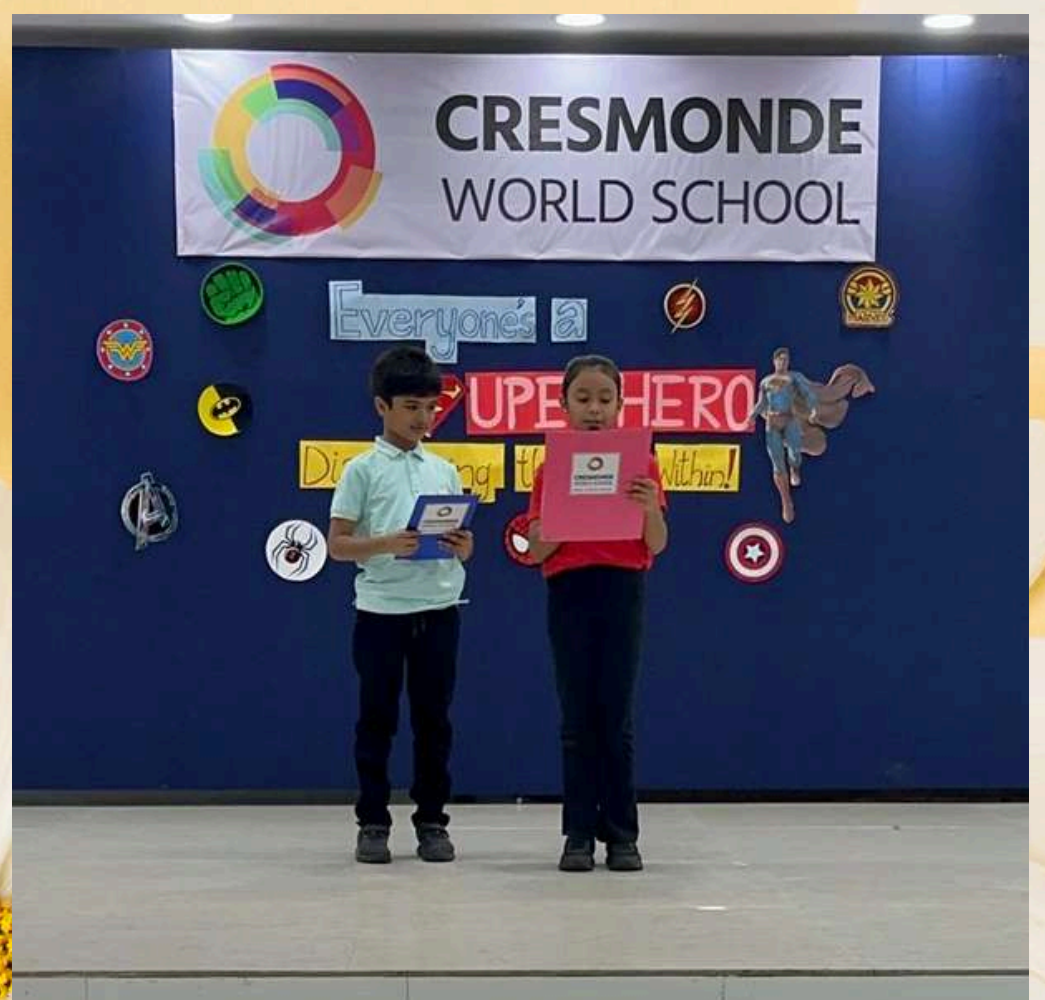

SENIOR KG – DRESS UP AS MYSELF DAY



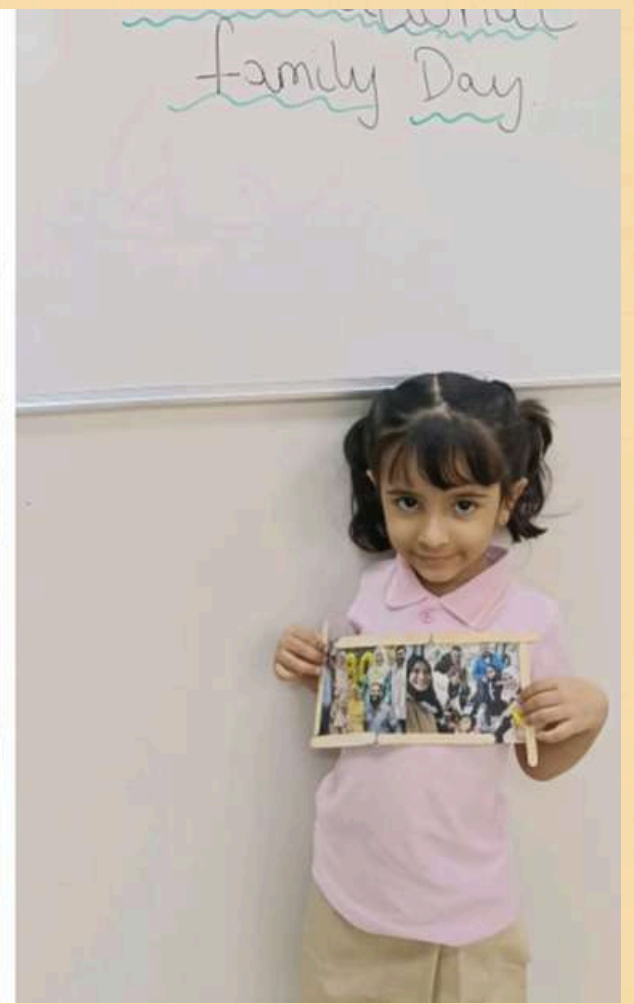

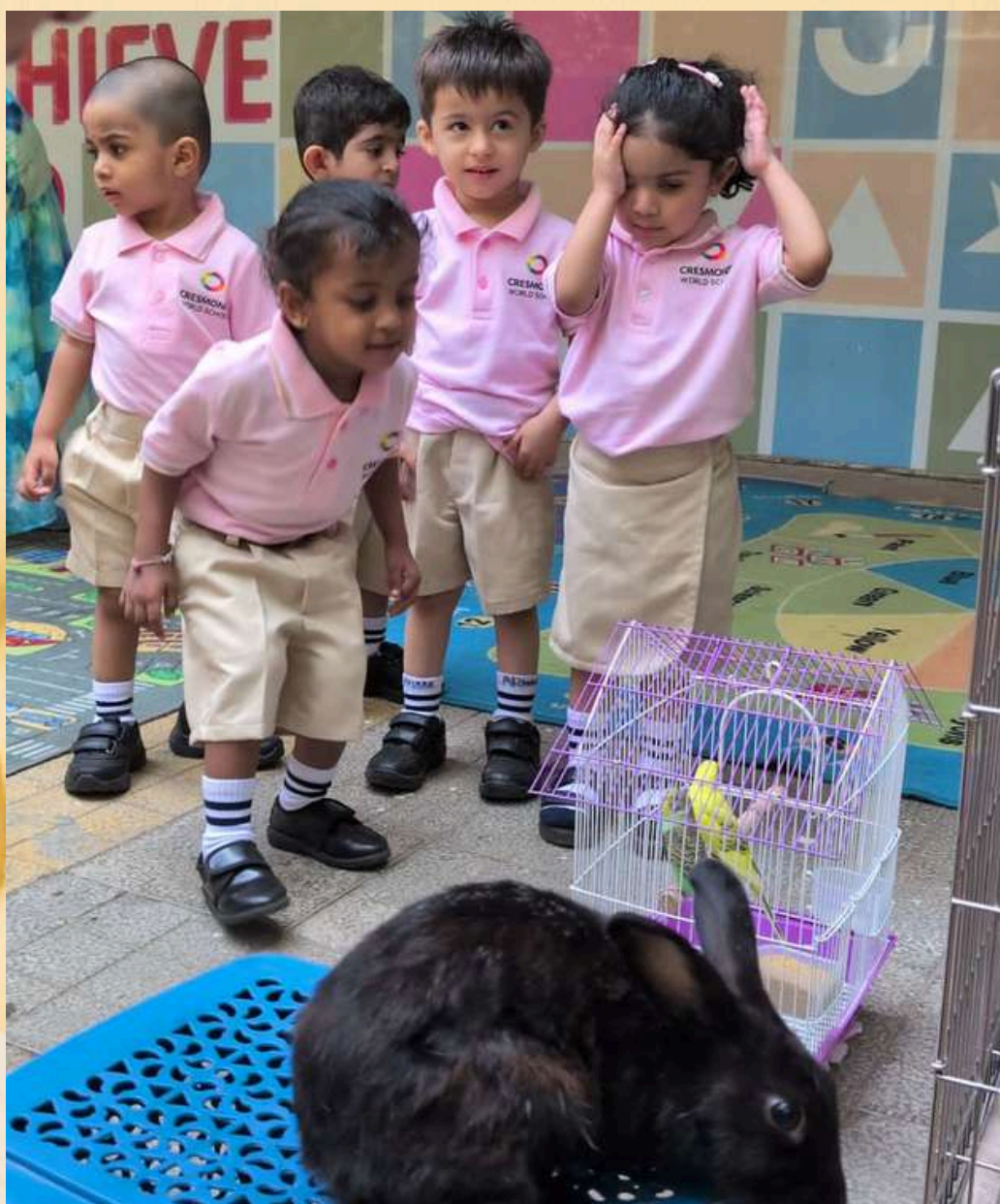
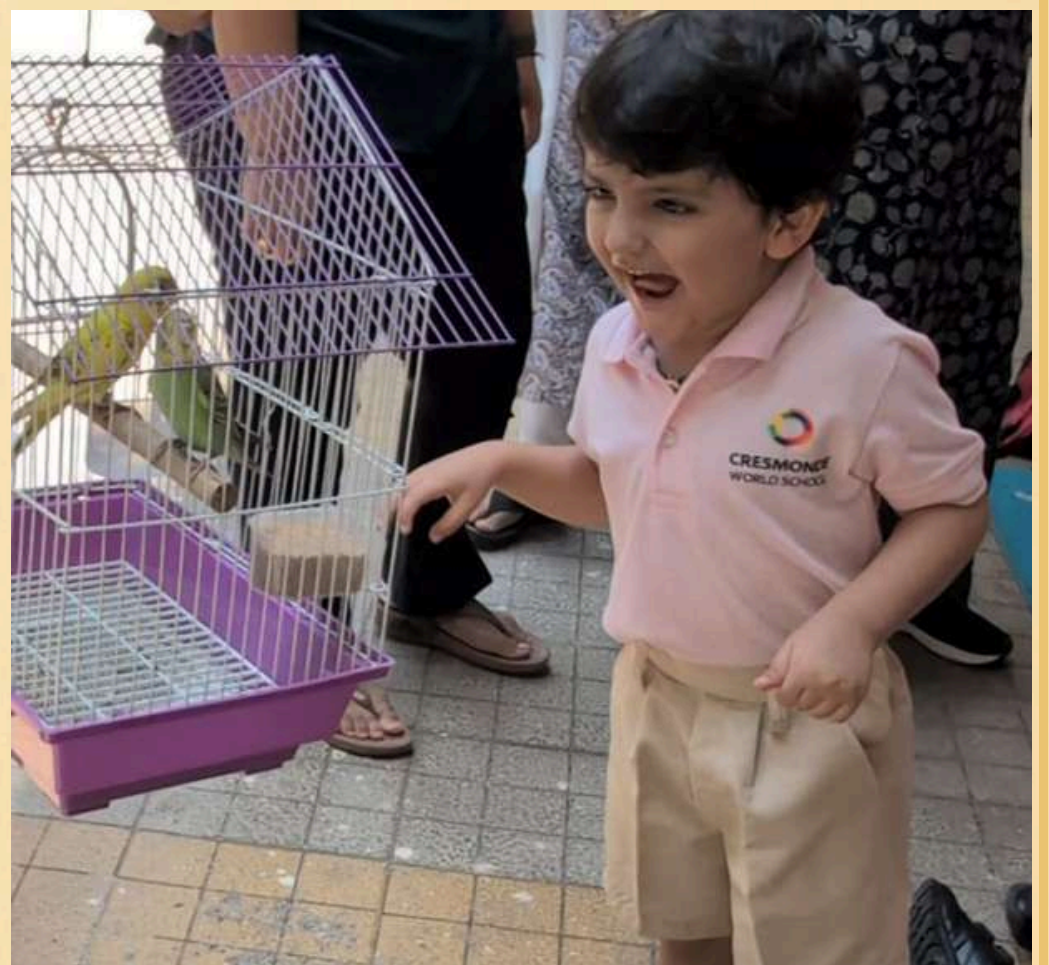




PET DAY AT PRESCHOOL

A fun-filled show with a sweet message about hard work and smart choices!



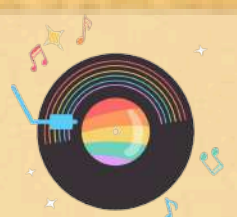
SENSE BOOTH
