




## **DIPLOMATHON**








# **JALSA 8.0**

On 31st July, Thursday, class 3B delivered a powerful and thoughtprovoking assembly on "Building Bridges:


















# FIELD TRIP(GRADE 5 & 6)

# FRENCH DAY



On 14th August, our preschoolers celebrated Independence Day with tricolor outfits, flags, and patriotic songs — a joyful tribute filled with pride and smiles!












#### **GANESH CHATURTHI CELEBRATION**

- 7) Hopefully have built any one of the tough LEGO sets Colosseum or The Upside Down!






